
- 1. Complete the Problems-Solutions Chart. List four different problems from the book, and how they were solved. Please write in complete sentences.
- 2. Write a letter to your favorite character from one of the books. Using letter format,

write a three-paragraph letter to one of the main characters, with 5-7 sentences in each paragraph.

Paragraph 1: Introduce yourself. Assume that the character doesn't know you.

Paragraph 2: Write about why you liked or did not like the book.

Paragraph 3: Write questions that you would like the character to answer. Explain if needed.
